OUR MISSION

Operating under the esteemed umbrella of the Ministry of Education, the Punjab Inclusivity Program is dedicated to revolutionizing the educational landscape. Endorsed by Rana Sikandar Hayat, the initiative bridges the gap between mainstream education and special needs, offering structural evaluations, mental health support, and skill development to ensure no student is left behind.



WHAT IS THIS INITIATIVE?

The Punjab Special Talent Hunt is a first-of-its-kind platform that celebrates the unique talents of special students across Punjab through Debating (English & Urdu) and Singing competitions.

RULES AND REGULATIONS (DEBATING COMPETITION)



- 1 The competition will comprise of one round only.
- 2 Each team will be represented by two speakers from cross categories. This is a compulsion for a team: if one member of the team chooses a serious topic from one language, the other will choose a humorous topic from the other language, and vice versa.
- 3 Individual speakers are also welcome.
- 4 Each speaker will be given 3 to 5 minutes. The first bell will be rung after 3 minutes. A second bell will be rung at 5 minutes. If the speaker continues even after the final bell, the judges may penalize or disqualify the speaker. (This time frame applies to both categories).
- 5 Paper reading is strictly not allowed. Those who do so will be disqualified.
- 6 Passing derogatory religious or sectarian remarks, or using derogatory words, will lead to instant disqualification. Humorous speakers will be disqualified for making sexist, racial, or ethnophobic remarks, or for targeting prominent figures.
- 7 A panel of judges will assess the performance of speakers for each category, and their decision will be final.
- 8 Both categories will have 3 positions. The team that gains the maximum aggregate points will win the Team Trophy.
- 9 The competition will comprise of one round only.

UNDER-19 CATEGORY (U-19)

In U-19, the three best speakers from Urdu and English categories will be awarded separately, but speakers must be enrolled in a school or college. Speakers registered in the U-19 category will not be eligible for the team trophy

RULES AND REGULATIONS (SINGING COMPETITION)



- 1** The competition will comprise of a single round for all participants.
- 2** Participants can choose to perform in Sufi, Light Classical, and Pakistani songs (Western music is not included in this competition).
- 3** Each singer will be allotted 3 to 5 minutes for their performance; exceeding the time limit may result in point deductions.
- 4** Song lyrics must adhere to ethical and social standards; any objectionable, political, or offensive content will result in immediate disqualification.
- 5** Evaluation will be based on Pitch/Sur, Rhythm/Taal, Diction, Voice Clarity, and Stage Expression.
- 6** The evaluation panel's decision will be final and unchallengeable.
- 7** Trophies and certificates will be awarded to the top 3 position holders of All Punjab.
